



Trends in U.S. violent and property crime, 1993-2019




% of U.S. adults who say there is more crime in ____ than there was a year ago






Rabbit/duck and geometric optical illusions. These are two examples of ambiguous images where viewers generally find it easy to switch between perspectives.









The way content is prioritized in our feeds by an algorithm





Basic Sorting Algorithm

Which content should be shown first to keep people on-site longer?


- 1. Sort content in order of likely engagement time
- 2. Serve content in order of likely engagement time






A simplified model of how we share on social media.







Breeds/types of dog involved in fatal attacks on humans in the U.S. from 2005 to 2017°







The intuitionist model, showing how we first feel intuitions, then judge them, then explain the justification to ourselves and others.








The dark valley of harm is "hidden" because widespread harm is often obscured by the flood of new users, or industry lobbying to keep a product in mainstream usage.



Humans adapt to new technologies like a fitness landscape, reaching higher (or lower) as we integrate and move between technologies.








Trust in government and perceptions of government fairness

Government fairness trend sources: National Election Studies and CBS/New York Times polls. Annual means calculated for years with more than one poll.





% of U.S. adults who say that, ideally, it's better for society if the American public is ...







Degrees of accuracy in types of sensemaking.








We use trust proxies to validate institutions that we have no direct access to. On social media, these can also be influencers we trust and follow, but do not know personally.





The Machine Called Democracy



The algorithm explores branches of the pathway, which represent subsets of the possible solution set. Before identifying the solution, the branch is checked against bounds on the optimal solution, and is discarded if it cannot produce a better solution than the best one found so far by the algorithm.
